WEATHER: Jacksonville has a moderate temperature year round. Florida's mild climate extends into the winter months, but there is a chance for cold temperatures - even frost - during the first half of the month in North and Central Florida. Even if it is cool in the morning, it is likely to warm up nicely in the afternoon. Average temperatures for February are High 67°- Low 44°.
