Pre-conference workshops will be held in the morning of the first conference day Wednesday, March 21st (9am-12pm) or in the afternoon (1pm-4pm), prior to the start of Annual Conference sessions.

Pre-conference sessions will be held as work-shop sessions. Work-shop session topics may include topics related to research designs, methods, dissemination strategies (e.g., publishing) or other topics approved by the governing boards. Speakers for the pre-conference sessions will not receive payment for these sessions.

4. AV requirements
5. Projected number of attendees
