		TSP-1: Diabetes ranks seventh in morbidity and mortality in the United States representing a significant health crisis. The American Diabetes Association provides annual Standards of Care to promote effective care practices designed to positively impact health outcomes of diabetic patients. A practice improvement project was designed to facilitate these care practices in a community health center organization with the aim of improving health outcomes of diabetic patients.	Lisa	Slade	
		TSP-2: The preterm birth and maternal mortality rates are 2 to 2.9 times higher for Black women than White women. Researchers have linked stress hormones to preterm birth and preeclampsia. Other researchers reported relationships between stress, glucocorticoid, corticotropin-releasing hormone (CRH), CRH post transcription factors to adverse maternal health.This study aimed to explore differences in perceived stress, glucocorticoid receptor (GR), and the histone acetylation (HAT) of the CRH gene between non-Hispanic Black and non-Hispanic White women in their second trimester of pregnancy. 		TSP-3: Pressure Injuries (PIs) are a major concern for US hospitals. Despite regulatory and financial pressure, rates of PIs have not declined at the same pace as other hospital acquired conditions. PI prevention begins with determining which patients are at risk. The Braden Scale has been the global gold standard for detecting PI risk for decades. However, taxonomy of nursing care has evolved, and the language of the Braden Scale has not kept current. In 2021, the authors of the Braden Scale worked with authors here to update the tool and develop a Braden Scale II©. The Braden Scale is one of the most studied tools in nursing. Padula and Black (2018) raised concern over the reliability of the Braden Scale citing that if nurses were not scoring the Braden correctly, the consequence would be failure to provide adequate PI prevention measures. 		TSP-4: Approximately 35% of adults aged 45 and over in the U.S. reported feeling lonely.Individuals with DM are twice as likely to have depression,which also increases the risk of experiencing loneliness.Loneliness and depression are associated with higher morbidity and mortality and they create significant challenges for older adults to manage DM.Although DM is known to be a risk factor for loneliness,there have been no studies on loneliness focusing on community-dwelling older adults with DM in the US.This study determined the frequency of loneliness among older adults with DM and compared the frequency of loneliness by demographic factors, diagnosis of other medical conditions, and functional limitations. 		TSP-5: Physical activity is a key factor for managing diabetes mellitus (DM) in older adults.Yet 28% of adults aged 50 and older reported engaging in no physical activity.Loneliness is a risk factor for physical inactivity.Individuals with DM are about twice as likely to have functional limitations and to have depression than those without DM, which can further increase the risk of physical inactivity and loneliness.Research on predictors of loneliness in older adults with DM has not been conducted so far in the U.S.Therefore, this study examines the predictors of loneliness and how well loneliness along with demographic characteristics, functional limitation, social support, and depressive symptoms predict physical activity in older adults with DM. 		<p>TSP-6: Purpose: Advance care planning (ACP) for rural-dwelling persons with lung cancer in the United States lacks sufficient study to assess goal-concordant care in this population. To fill the gap, this study examined demographic and clinical factors associated with ACP documentation among rural-dwelling persons with lung cancer. We aimed to (1) describe sample demographic and clinical characteristics; and (2) examine associations between demographic and clinical variables and ACP documentation.
</p> <p>Significance: This study supports the SNRS vision “to lead transformation of health outcomes” by expanding nursing knowledge about the urgent need for ACP to actualize goal-concordant end-of-life (EOL) care for rural-dwelling persons with lung cancer.</p>	Lauren	Catlett	
		<p>TSP-7: Non-ventilator hospital acquired pneumonia (NV-HAP) impacts 1 in 100 patients and is associated with mortality rates of 13.1% to 30.0%, costs up to \$40,000/case, and a 15.9 day increase in hospital length of stay. NV-HAP develops from aspiration of oral secretions into the lungs, and is associated with clinical factors (oral bacterial colonization and poor oral care). This study explored the relationship between pre-hospital residence (nursing home vs. home) and non-ventilated patients’ oral microbiome. We hypothesized that nursing home patients would have (1) different baseline oral bacterial taxonomy; and (2) lower oral microbial diversity than those from home.</p>	Kimberly	Rathbun	
		<p>TSP-8: Black mothers are substantially more likely to deliver preterm, predisposing their infants to potentially preventable lifelong complications. Mother’s own milk (MOM) has been proven to mitigate these complications but access to MOM is not equitable among critically ill infants born in the US. Although Black and non-Black mothers have similar lactation goals, Black infants receive significantly less MOM at neonatal intensive care unit (NICU) discharge. Thus, novel strategies to mitigate these disparities are urgently needed. 		<p>TSP-9: The gut microbiome (GM) is affected by socioeconomic status (SES) through various pathways such as diet and environment. Studies show that low GM diversity and high abundance of opportunistic bacteria are more common in people with low SES. Also, low SES is a predictor of low quality of life (QoL). Yet, little is known about the relationship between GM and SES on QoL. This study aimed to evaluate associations of GM and SES with QoL in women with gynecologic cancers pre- and post-treatment.</p>	Sofia	Cordover	
		<p>TSP-10: Informal caregivers of individuals living with Alzheimer’s disease and related dementias have an increased risk for experiencing psychological distress and depressive symptoms. Further, emerging evidence suggests that dementia family caregivers have an increased risk for suicidal ideation. Contextual risk factors associated with an increased risk of experiencing psychological distress and depression, such as the stress of managing behavioral symptoms of dementia (BSDs) exhibited by the person living with dementia, social isolation, and a perceived lack of control have previously been examined; however, relatively little is known about daily contextual risk factors associated with suicidal ideation among dementia family caregivers.
