The Southern Nursing Research Society Annual Conference provides an opportunity for SNRS members to report ongoing and completed research as well as theoretical, conceptual, and methodological projects to colleagues.

The abstract submission site for **Symposia, podium and poster presentations (with the exception of student posters)** is now open for the 2018 SNRS Annual Conference. (The majority of podium presentations are selected from the first call for submissions. Students are encouraged to submit an abstract for podium presentation as long as all other criteria listed are met.) The deadline for submitting abstracts is **Tuesday, June 13, 2017 at 5:00 pm CT. There will be NO extension.**

New for 2018: As a result of feedback from the membership, the Board has approved and implemented a \$25 submission fee for each abstract. Once payment is made through the [SNRS website](#) you will receive a link to the submission site. The link is provided in your receipt for payment.

The student/late breaker poster and general session abstract submission site will open in early September 2017.

Please review the submission guidelines **and NEW rating form on the [SNRS website](#)**. These documents contain important information regarding abstract submission, including what types of abstracts SNRS does and does not accept and items that you will need prior to starting the abstract submission process. **Reviewing this information in advance will greatly facilitate the submission process.**

SNRS membership is NOT required at the time of abstract submission. However, membership is REQUIRED at the time of presentation, if you are selected. ENRS, MNRS, and WIN members may also submit abstracts documenting proof of membership.
