Good news, because we recognized that there were issues with submitting your abstracts for the 2018 Annual Conference in Atlanta, we have re-opened the submission window and extended the deadline until Wednesday June 21st, 5 pm CT. Part of the issue was that we now require a [\\$25 payment](#) before you can upload your abstracts. Please understand that these payments must be processed by a staff member during normal business hours. Receipts for payment, with the abstract link, will be provided only during normal business hours. **Please plan accordingly.**

We recognize that the system used for uploading your abstracts is a bit cumbersome. We will have a simpler system next year so please bare with the current system, Scholar One. At the beginning of the submission process is a request for the [Presenter Biographical Data Form](#). This form is not a PDF fillable form and must be downloaded, filled out and uploaded at the end of step 2. We are providing the form [here](#) in order to facilitate a smoother submission process. Submission guidelines and other information can be found on the [SNRS website](#).

For symposium presentations, each presenter must pay the \$25 fee and upload their own abstract along with their Presenter Biographical Data Form. The Symposium leader will then complete the process and tie these all together and submit as one. There is no additional fee for the overview.

Thank you very much for your patience and perseverance with this new payment process and submission. We have extended the deadline in recognition of the challenges and sincerely to provide you with a quality program in Atlanta!

The Southern Nursing Research Society Annual Conference provides an opportunity for SNRS members to report ongoing and completed research as well as theoretical, conceptual, and methodological projects to colleagues.

SNRS membership is NOT required at the time of abstract submission. However, membership is REQUIRED at the time of presentation, if you are selected. ENRS, MNRS, and WIN members may also submit abstracts documenting proof of membership.
